

University Learning Outcome #2 - Self Directed and Lifelong Learning

Graduates will be aware of the limits of one's personal knowledge and experience and have an intellectual interest in scholarly and creative endeavors. Graduates will actively set appropriate learning goals, pursue them, and apply the knowledge gained.

Criteria for Assessment:

1. Awareness of limits

- a. The graduate will be able to recognize and evaluate personal limits in knowledge, skills and experience.

2. Rectification of limitations

- a. The graduate will be able to set goals to rectify gaps in knowledge.
- b. The graduate will be able to research, review, and extract data from multiple sources.
- c. The graduate will be able to confer with knowledgeable colleagues, advisors, or experts.

3. Application of knowledge

- a. Develops adaptive strategies and applies acquired knowledge to minimize the limitations of one's knowledge, skills and experience.

4. Intellectual interest

- a. The graduate will be able to read relevant literature.
- b. The graduate will be able to exploit new opportunities for intellectual growth and professional enlightenment; e.g., additional courses, workshops.
