How Much Money Can I Get?

Financial Aid – Chiropractic Program

Chiropractic Student- Federal Graduate/Health Profession Limits

Maximum Loan Limits Per Term (Trimester)*

Subsidized Stafford Loan (Need Based –determined by Federal guidelines)	\$4,250/Term	\$8,500/Two Terms
Unsubsidized Stafford Loan (Non-Need Based)	Up to \$12,250/Term (not to exceed budget)	Up to \$24,500/Two Terms (not to exceed budget)

- A graduate student may be eligible for both \$8,500 + \$24,500 = \$33,000/two terms + Perkins + Work Study (**if qualifies for need based aid**).
- A graduate student may apply for a budget adjustment for expenses accrued for the following reasons: non-routine emergency car repair, computer purchase (needed for coursework at NWHSU), courses required for the Bachelor of Science degree, board exam fees, and daycare expenses (**approval required by Financial Aid Director**).

Maximum Unsubsidized Stafford	\$158,500
Maximum Perkins	\$40,000 (Variable based on NWHSU allocations)
