The following information is Northwestern Health Sciences University's policy about privacy of consumer financial information.

Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act Notice

Northwestern Health Sciences University, federal school code 012328, provides notice of our policy pertaining to the right to privacy as outlined by the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act.

Northwestern Health Sciences University:

- Will follow the current policy regarding confidentiality that has been listed under the Federal Education Right and Policy Act (FERPA). A copy of this document may be obtained through the Registrar's Office.
- Will not disclose nonpublic personal information to any institution that does not have a direct affiliation with the institution. Nonpublic information will only be shared with affiliates working on behalf of the lender pertaining to Federal Stafford loans of the borrower.
- Will not sell or provide nonpublic information any entity not affiliated with the institutions, such as credit bureaus, telemarketing firms, direct mail or other marketing through electronic mail to the consumer, etc.

Northwestern Health Sciences University Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act Notice

What is the purpose of this notice?

This notice is to provide you information about our privacy policies in connection with the student loan you received or applied for while enrolled at Northwestern Health Sciences University. We want you to understand what information we collect and how we use it. In order to provide our customers with financial services and products effectively and conveniently as possible, we use technology to manage and maintain customer information. The following policy serves as a standard for all Northwestern students for academic and loan information:

What information do we collect?

Northwestern collects “nonpublic personal information” about you from the following sources:

- Information we receive from you on applications or other forms.
- Information about your transactions with our affiliates, others or us.
- Information we receive from a consumer-reporting agency.

What information do we disclose?

We are permitted under law to disclose nonpublic personal information about you to third parties in certain circumstances. For example, we may disclose nonpublic personal information about you to a third party to assist us in processing your student loan application or servicing your student loan account with us to the government entities in response to subpoenas, and to credit bureaus.

We may disclose all the information that we collect, as described above, to companies that perform student loan marketing services on our behalf or to other financial institutions with which we have joint marketing arrangements regarding student loans. Northwestern Health Sciences University does not and will not sell or otherwise provide nonpublic personal information about you to Northwestern Health Sciences University affiliates or other third parties for the purpose of marketing non-student loan related products and services.

We do not disclose nonpublic personal information about our customers or former customers to anyone, except as permitted by law.

If you decide to no longer be enrolled at Northwestern Health Sciences University, we will continue to adhere to the privacy policies and practices described in this notice.

What are our Confidentiality and Security Procedures?

We restrict access to nonpublic personal information about you to those employees who need to know that information in order to provide products and services for you. We maintain physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards that comply with federal regulations to guard your nonpublic personal information.
