**Biographical History** (written by former library technician Corinne Florin)

John Burton Wolfe was born July 27, 1914, in Grand Forks, North Dakota. After graduating from the University of Minnesota with a degree in civil engineering in 1936, his interests turned to a different area, and he entered Palmer College of Chiropractic in Iowa. He returned to Minnesota after graduation, only to find Minnesota required basic science, so Dr. Wolfe entered the Minnesota Chiropractic College and earned his second D.C. in 1940.

In June of 1941, Dr. Wolfe founded Northwestern College of Chiropractic, housed on the sixth floor of a downtown Minneapolis department store. He wanted to make sure future chiropractors attended an institution that encompassed Minnesota's basic science law, and he believed that more students would be helpful in any possible necessary political influence. The school flourished after WWII, and by 1949, enrollment had grown to 280 students, and NWCC adopted a nonprofit status. As the school grew, it changed locations several times until its current location in Bloomington, Minnesota.

Dr. Wolfe was the college's first president and remained so until his retirement in 1984, after serving 43 years in that office. He died on November 24, 1998.
